WHY GOOD FOOD BUCKS?



City Green's Good Food Bucks Program is a SNAP Nutrition Incentive Program for New

Jerseyans. The mission of the Good Food Bucks program is to support New Jersey fresh food retailers in their efforts to increase the affordability of healthy, Jersey-fresh produce for low-income families at their markets, while also creating greater economic opportunities for farmers and local businesses. All participating fresh food retailers receive funding, training, and technical assistance to facilitate a successful program that ensures that all of our neighbors can double the amount of fresh fruits and vegetables on their tables while simultaneously supporting the people who grow our food. The Good Food Bucks Program is NJ's largest statewide SNAP Nutrition Incentive Program, operating at fresh food retailers in 20 counties and 60 cities. Good Food Bucks DOUBLES customers' purchasing power for fresh fruits and vegetables and generates increased incomes for local farms and businesses. Good Food Bucks is a triple win because it positively impacts health, community, and economic development!

GOOD FOOD BUCKS ARE GOOD FOR NEW JERSEY!

The Good Food Bucks program is a TRIPLE WIN because it positively impacts health, community, and economic development simultaneously by encouraging shoppers who use SNAP to reinvest their fresh produce dollars back into the local economy.

Ask your legislators to SUPPORT SNAP Nutrition Incentives because they are:

GOOD FOR PUBLIC HEALTH

- Doubling the purchasing power of shoppers with SNAP makes healthy foods more affordable.
- Customers who use SNAP Nutrition Incentives like Good Food Bucks increase their fruit and vegetable consumption by ¼ cup per person.
- Customers who use SNAP Nutrition Incentives like Good Food Bucks consume more fruits and vegetables than the average adult.

GOOD FOR THE ECONOMY

- For every dollar invested into SNAP in NJ, \$1.70 is generated into the local economy. Good Food Bucks increase the value of SNAP benefits, at the point of sale (participating food retail sites), when spent on fruits and vegetables
- Good Food Bucks increases traffic and sales for participating markets and grocers, stimulating local economies

GOOD FOR FARMERS

- The Good Food Bucks Program supports New Jersey's farmers by expanding their customer base, increasing their produce sales, and strengthening connections to the communities they serve.
- Good Food Bucks increase incomes for farmers and supports New Jersey's agricultural communities

EMAIL/LETTER TEMPLATE

Emailing, calling, or mailing a letter to elected officials about a topic that is important to you gives them more information about what matters to the public they are serving. They want to hear from their constituents about their priorities. You can use this template below and personalize it to share with your legislators why you think they should support Good Food Bucks and Fruit and Vegetable Incentives.

As an advocate for nutrition security, I fully support the GusNIP program because it improves affordability of nutritious, fresh produce for families and individuals who use SNAP, while also increasing revenues for New Jersey's farmers and fresh food retailers.

I am a concerned citizen deeply invested in supporting local farmers and affordable access to nutritious food in my community. Our **[farm/market]** relies on federal support for vital programs that sustain our farm and market operation and help connect people using SNAP, WIC, and FMNP to healthy local food through nutrition incentive programs. A reduction or pause of federal GusNIP aid would have a devastating impact on New Jersey's farmers and citizens, and on our food system as a whole.

In New Jersey, GusNIP supports programs like Good Food Bucks SNAP Nutrition Incentives, so that they reach more families and individuals. Since 2021, more than \$620,000 Good Food Bucks Nutrition Incentives have been redeemed by SNAP-using customers for fresh produce. Fruit and Vegetable Incentive Programs have been shown to positively impact health, community, and economic development by encouraging SNAP shoppers to reinvest their benefit dollars into the local economy. Good Food Bucks and programs like it are good for public health, local economies, and agricultural communities - a triple win!
